 In the last two years, have successfully had language passed to hold off over \$1 BILLION in proposed imaging cuts.




 Ensured that the federal "surprise" medical billing legislation signed into law held patients harmless and created an equitable process for

RADPAC's Value

- Only **30 of 535 (6%)** of Members of Congress have a healthcare background.
- RADPAC educates Members of Congress by attending 500+ events a year on the Hill.
- RADPAC organizes 15+ site visits a year to show Members of Congress how radiology works.
- RADPAC is focused on ensuring appropriate legislative fixes to surprise billing and E/M cuts.

RADPAC Disbursements

In 2021, RADPAC disbursed \$352,906 to Members of Congress and their committees.



Utah had the highest percentage of their radiologists contribute to RADPAC — 52% participation rate.
